Main Foyer and Walk

Capacity: 2000

Touring Hall and Foyer

Capacity: Foyer 500 | Hall 1000

Treetops

Capacity: 180

Floor-to-ceiling glass envelops this purpose-built function space, allowing beautiful views over the historic Carlton Gardens. Unparalleled facilities include dedicated bar, private bathroom and high-quality AV capability

Melbourne Gallery

Capacity: 350

An immersive display of some of the most fascinating elements that make Melbourne marvellous, from a Luna Park relic to an AC/DC costume and, of course, our most beloved Phar Lap.

Science and Life Gallery

Capacity: 300

Dance among the dinosaurs. The Science and Life Gallery is home to beloved exhibitions *Dinosaur Walk*, *600 Million Years*, *Bugs Alive!*, *Dynamic Earth* and the brand new, one of its kind *Triceratops: Fate of the Dinosaurs*.

North Terrace

Capacity: 250

Take in the fresh air and dusk views of Carlton Gardens. Stemming off Treetops and bordering the Forest Gallery, this leafy and expansive outdoor courtyard is ideal for daytime and early evening functions in the warmer months.

Birrarung

Capacity: 450

This large, winding space is located within Bunjilaka Aboriginal Cultural Centre and named after the Boon Wurrung and Woi Wurrung word for the Yarra River. Step outside the glass double doors and into the adjoining Milarri Garden, home to native flora that has been integral to First Peoples for over 40,000 years.
